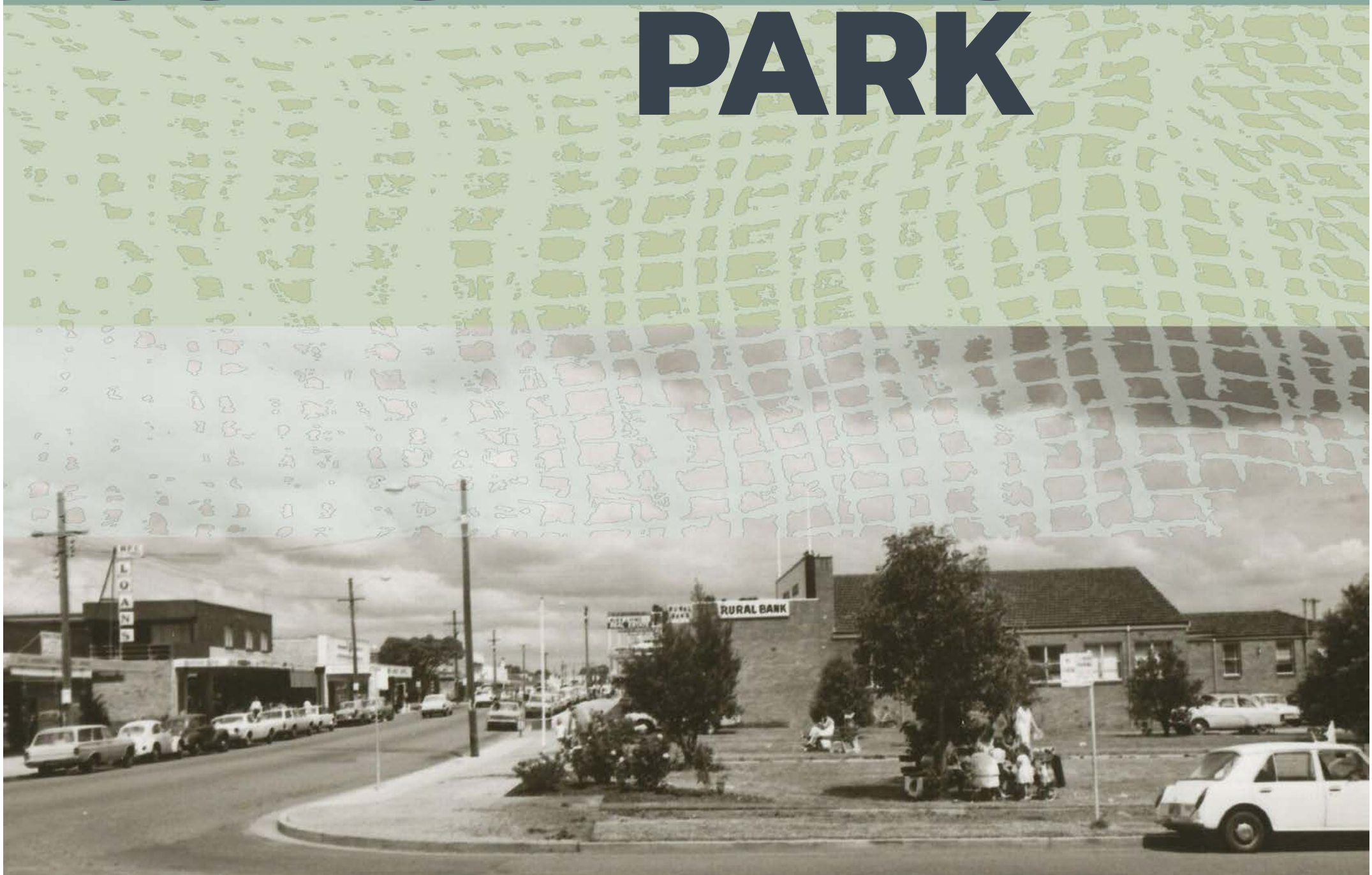


COACHMAN'S PARK
